


- 1. Remove the (2) screws from the trim plate assembly and detach from the back box.
- 2. Carefully remove the LED indicator light and the ground wire from the trim plate and disconnect the wire harness.
- 3. Select the desired mounting area, taking into consideration accessibility to perform installation.
- 4. Place the provided template against the mounting surface where the RM2 will be installed and trace the outer edge. Use this outline to cut the hole for the back box.

Caution: Live wires, conduit or water pipes may be present.

- 5. Remove the necessary knockout for routing wires. Fig. 1
- 6. Mount the back box in place using the provided hanger bars. Fig. 2
- 7. Adjust the brackets until the bottom of the back box is even with the mounting surface and tighten to hold in place. Fig 3.
- 8. Make AC connections per "Wiring Section".











- 9. Reattach the trim plate assembly to the back box by pinching together the spring clips and hooking them into the slots located on the outside of the back box.
- 10. Carefully reconnect the LED indicator light, ground wire, wire harness and battery connections.

Warning: Connect battery only after continuous AC power can be provided to the unit.

11. Secure the trim plate assembly to the back box with the two screws (removed in step 1). Adjust the lamp heads to the desired orientation.

WIRING

Make electrical connections as follows:

White - Common Black - 120VAC Orange/Red - 277VAC

Important: Electrical connections should be made inside junction box (supplied by others).

Caution: Failure to cap unused wires may result in shock hazard or unsafe condition as well as equipment failure.
